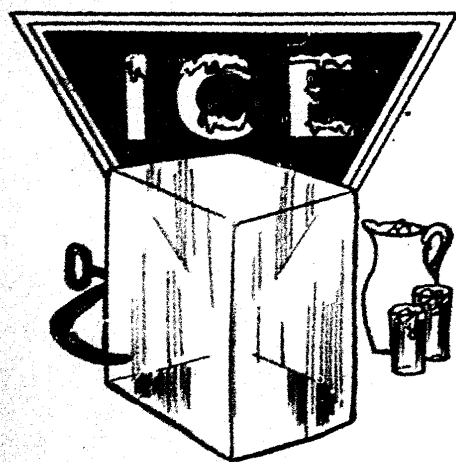

THE Walsh roads, the Southern Indiana, to the south, and the Chicago Southern, to the north, are to be taken out of the receiver's hands and sold. A reorganization of the companies to take place at once, and the Chicago capitalists who have put their money into the enterprise see a way of getting out safely. The Walsh coal companies have already been taken out of receiver's hands, and are now owned by the Alliance Coal company, made up of the people who are to take over the railroads."

"United States Trust company buys \$40,000 worth of city bonds at a premium of \$1,112.40, which was more than a \$1,000 higher than offered by the other Terre Haute bidder, the American-German Trust company, which bid a premium of \$80. The bonds are in denominations of \$1,000, at 4 per cent, run for twenty years and proceeds are to be used in building sewers."

"Terre Haute's first airplane, made by the Johnson Brothers, is to have a try-out soon. It is to be made in some out-of-the-way place to avoid the crowds. If successful a public demonstration is to be given at once."

"Andrew J. Gosnell, who died recently, was one of the last of the old river pilots, formerly identified with Terre Haute in the navigation of the Wabash river. He was born in the square now occupied by St. Joseph's church, and his father hauled the first load of merchandise from Louisville to Terre Haute. He had been a steamboatman since he was 18 years of age, and had lived here all his life."

"Mayor Louis Gerhardt starts movement for \$10,000 or \$15,000 addition to present fire headquarters on Ninth street."

"Miss Mary Sinclair Crawford, of the King Classical school, who is conducting a party of young women through Europe this summer, and Miss Helen Graham, were recently granted an audience with Pope Pius IX. It was secured through the efforts of Miss Graham, who is a Catholic, and no other members of the party were admitted to the audience."

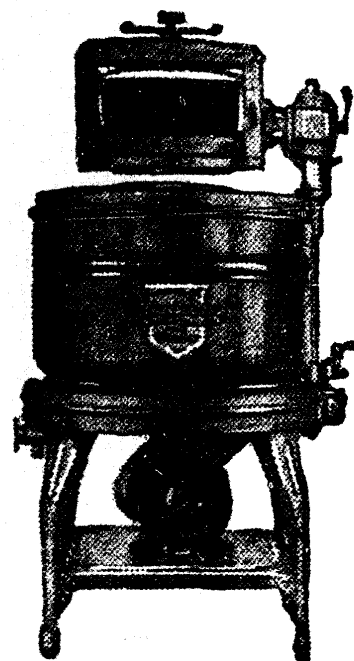

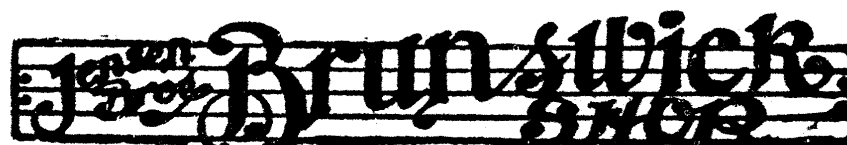

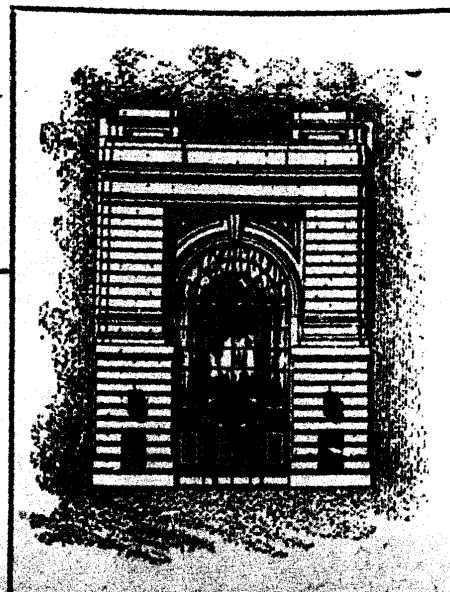
