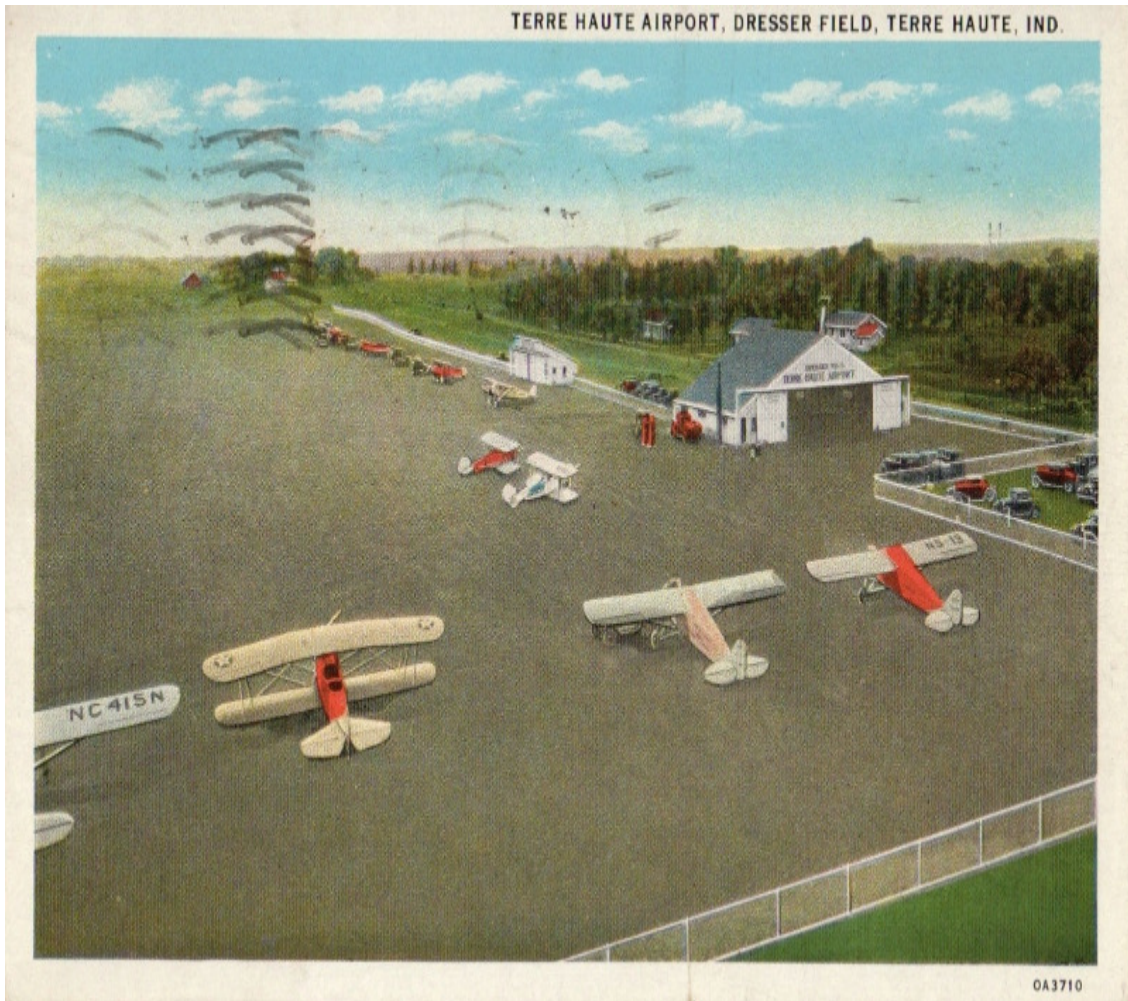

The current airport director, Brigadier General Jeffrey Hauser, gave a presentation to the group on unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV). Terre Haute international airport is the first class D airport in the country to acquire a UAV certificate of authorization (COA). This will allow the use of a specific UAV within the class D airspace. General Hauser states that the primary concern with the use of UAVs in the airspace will be the safety for general aviation. He discussed the possible uses, restrictions, and requirements for a UAV to be used in the airport's airspace. He also discussed the process of attaining the COA and areas of operation at the Terre Haute International airport.

At the end of the presentation, General Hauser had a Q&A session and brought us up to date on current airport news.

At the end of the meeting, Alan Harder welcomed new member, Christopher Hurst.

The fly-out to Rantoul was called off due to weather.
